Doctor en Teoria i Història de l'Arquitectura per l'ETSAB, el seu treball com a arquitecte i investigador connecta l'arquitectura, els estudis teatrals i la teoria de les arts. Holding a Ph.D. In History and Theory of Architecture from ETSAB, his work as an architect and researcher bridges architecture, theatre studies, and art theory. Alongside his published research in Academic Journals, he has been a visiting critic and lecturer at the Chelsea College of Arts (UAL), ENSA Paris-Malaquais, the Aarhus School of Architecture and the Berliner Hochschule für Technik, among others. Previously, he was a researcher and lecturer at UPC-ETSAB Barcelona and held the Pilar Juncosa's Research Fellowships at the Miró Mallorca Foundation in 2024-2025.
